## **DRILLING UPDATE: STRONG MINERALISATION INTERCEPTED**

Diamond and RC drilling continues at Sabre Resources Ltd's ('Sabre') Border and Irvington prospects.

**Strong lead and zinc mineralisation** has been intercepted at numerous intervals within a **broad ~40 to 80 m thick halo of disseminated and vein-hosted sulphides**. Initial interpretations suggest that coherent mineralised zones correlate between drill cores. Logging indicates that **visible copper mineralisation is widely dispersed throughout the mineralised envelope**.

**RC drilling is close to completion**, with 12 of 15 drillholes completed. In addition, 13 pre-collars for subsequent drilling as diamond tails have been completed. Diamond drilling is ongoing, with 8 of 22 planned holes (comprising 9 diamond holes and 13 diamond tails) completed. Logging and packaging of samples on site is ongoing, and the first shipment of samples is due in Johannesburg for processing and sample preparation next week (13 June 2008). Assaying will then be performed in Perth.

Sabre will provide assay results for these extensive mineralised zones as they become available.
